Pinot Noir

Appellation: Oregon

Vintage: 2010 was a cooler vintage but with a warm, dry finish. This led to elegant, lighter bodied, but fully colored wines.

Harvest: 3rd week of October

Winemaking: Fruit was destemmed and pumped into 12 ton fermenters, where it was pumped over twice a day. The wine was pressed and racked to barrel for 6 months, before being returned to tank and bottled.

Aromas: Strawberries and baking spice dominate, with undertones of sweet toasted oak.

Flavors and Mouthfeel: Flavors of baking spice and red fruit lead to a medium body and a lingering finish.
